## Homeowners' comments:

A homeowner complained that the appeal committee didn't address the fine specifically (leash length vs poop cleanup).

Another homeowner complained that the Grounds Committee should reconsider removing wild/weed/rhizome Cottonwood trees before they become an even bigger problem.

**Compliance Committee report** by Deloris

36 letters... 32 courtesy and 4 fines.

Pictures showing oil stain from tow truck... another fine to be sent to property owner. Letter sent to owner that rent will be collected from renters to pay dues, fines, and fees; if non-compliance to rules continues. Letter mentions possible eviction as well.

Architectural Committee... no report.

Budget Committee... by Donna.

Unbudgeted pool repairs cost greater than \$3,600.

Park Report by Bruce.

Unplanned pool repairs (filters & water heater for shower) and 2<sup>nd</sup> pump rebuild in the vault are unbudgeted. Otherwise monthly operating expenses are as expected.

Pool was closed for July 4<sup>th</sup>, due to unsafe water quality

Bid to remove large problem Cottonwood on Pond 1 is \$2000.

Pond 2 is dry. Bruce says Hydrologists suggested that Pond 2 is losing water to the low water table. Charlie suggests damning pond 2. Greg suggests dredging and liner. Another option is to re-landscape it to a smaller pond or stream (negative: swamp during rainy times).

Report of HOA members in arrears.

Report of park maintenance.

Garbage company tried to increase the HOA's monthly cost by \$400. Bruce renegotiated down to the previous cost with a 1 year commitment.
