<u>ANNUAL MEETING:</u> Mark your calendars!!! The Barrington Park Annual Meeting will be held Wednesday September 22, 2021, at 6:00 pm. <u>SUMMER HEAT IS HERE:</u> Summer is here and until the last week it has been HOT and dry! This kind of heat is taking a toll on all of us and our lawns and gardens.

In response to the water conservation order issued by Governor Cox, The Board of Directors and Grounds Committee decided to limit the watering of the grass to twice a week. When the grass turns tan or brown it becomes dormant, and it will come back next year. This is happening because of the extreme drought not only in Utah, but in the surrounding states. Please be aware that homeowners may need to have water beds to help keep flowers alive at this time. <u>MAIL & MAILBOXES:</u> Over the last several weeks we have found a small number of mailboxes open. We have replaced the locks and have reported this to the USPS and law enforcement. We have a few suggestions which we hope will bring this to an end and protect you. Please consider the following:

- Pick up your mail daily. Do not leave mail in your mailbox overnight.
- If you are out of town, have the post office hold your mail at the post office until you return. This can be done by visiting <a href="https://www.usps.com/manage/">https://www.usps.com/manage/</a> and scheduling a "Mail Hold".
- Sign up for "informed delivery" with USPS. This allows you to preview images of your mail that will be delivered that day and report any items you may not have received directly to USPS. - Promptly report suspicious activities in the mailbox area to law enforcement and management.

<u>SWIMMING POOL REMINDERS:</u> The pool will be closing for the season at 9:00 pm, September 6, 2021, which is the end of the Labor Day holiday. It has been a busy year at the pool! Thanks to all of you who use the pool, obey the rules and are courteous to other swimmers. A few reminders regarding the pool are:

- ID will be required to enter the pool. This is for the safety and wellbeing of Barrington Park homeowners.
- Children must always be accompanied by an adult.
- Residents are to sanitize any chairs and tables used by them when leaving the pool area. Supplies will be available at the pool.
- Each household is allowed a maximum of five guests at the pool per visit and the homeowner must be present at all times.
- The maximum number of people allowed at the pool at one time cannot exceed 60.

A late charge of \$25.00 or 5%, whichever is greater, <u>will</u> be charged for any payment received after the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month.

<u>AUTOMATIC HOA PAYMENTS:</u> For your convenience, Barrington Park can set up a reoccurring withdrawal (ACH) directly from your financial institution. It is easy, secure (no need to worry about fraud), and prevents late payments and late fees.
