<u>SPRING IS IN THE AIR!</u> It's officially spring! The days are getting warmer, flowers are starting to bloom and the trees are beginning to blossom. Spring is a beautiful time around Barrington Park. As we move into the warmer spring and summer months, we wanted to give you a few reminders:

- The streets can be congested with kids, bikes & pedestrians. Please slow down when driving through Barrington Park.
- Please caution your children, grandchildren and guests about the ponds and water hazards. NEVER let them play in the ponds. If they play around the ponds, close supervision is required.
- The playground is a great source of fun and activity. However, it should only be used by children with adult supervision. Although Barrington Park does all it can to maintain the grounds and equipment in a safe manner, the Barrington Park Homeowners Association assumes no responsibility for injury caused by use, or misuse, of the grounds or equipment. Please be careful!

<u>SPRING CLEANUP:</u> Spring and the warmer weather bring a lot of activity to Barrington Park. Our maintenance crew has already started spring cleanup. Aeration of the lawns has been completed and fertilization and weed control will be applied within the first two weeks of April, weather permitting. Bushes and trees will be getting trimmed and soon we will begin mowing lawns.

CARDBOARD & PAPER DUMPSTER:

We have had homeowners request that the *cardboard dumpster* located to the north of the tennis courts be removed from Barrington Park, due to the fact that boxes are being disposed of without being broken down/flattened. This results in an overflowing dumpster making the area look bad. Additionally, the dumpster is being used to dispose of household items, like furniture, doors & cabinets from remodeling, and even kitchen & bathroom trash.

Barrington Park could receive compensation of \$15 per ton of uncontaminated cardboard/paper products, which HAS NOT occurred a single time over the last 3 years.

The Board of Directors would like to get feedback from you!!! Should the dumpster remain onsite, or should it be removed from Barrington Park?
