<u>COLD WEATHER REMINDERS:</u> As we move from fall into winter and prepare for snow and colder temperatures, we have a few winter weather reminders:

1. <u>HOSE BIBS</u>: Just a reminder, be sure your outside hose is disconnected from the hose bib and turn the water off to the hose bib either by a valve inside your home or that a freeze free valve is installed and working properly.

2. SNOW REMOVAL:

- Snow removal is completed when storms accumulate a depth of 2 or more inches.
- Streets: Streets are given a priority. The first areas are the entrances and around the post office, followed by the main streets and finally the side streets. Please remember no parking on the streets overnight and no parking overnight in guest parking without permits.
- Sidewalks and driveways: As with street plowing, sidewalks and driveways are completed on a priority system. First being the post office, next the major walk areas then the rest of the drives and walks. In other words, they will eventually get to you and are happy to do so. It simply takes time, so please be a little patient with us and know we will get to you. Any help that is provided by you is appreciated and expedites the whole snow removal process, allowing the crew to work on other things. The crew does not remove snow from patio or deck areas.
- Ice: Along with snow removal are the ice hazards that cold weather brings. Ice Melt (Not Salt) is available for owners (do not use salt on any of the cement surfaces). Please refrain from using ice melt or salt on the new cement. Ice melt is available by calling or picking up at the office.

MAIL & PACKAGES: As the holidays approach, we always see an increase in packages being delivered around Barrington Park. A few reminders regarding package delivery:

- 1. UPS, FedEx, and Amazon will all deliver directly to your home. If you are expecting a package and will not be home, you may want to have it delivered to a neighbor or somewhere other than the front steps.
- 2. USPS (US Postal Service) will deliver to the parcel lockers by the mailboxes. Two new parcel lockers have been installed this past year; however, at times there are not enough parcel lockers. If this happens the mail carrier will often leave a note in your mailbox letting you know the package is in the office.

*We strongly suggest that residents check and pick up their mail and packages everyday rather than leaving them overnight.

INSURANCE REMINDER: Each homeowner is responsible to maintain a unit owner's insurance policy to insure all personal property contained within the unit and the personal liability of the unit owner. They should also have liability coverage for the \$10,000 deductible that is the owner's responsibility before the HOAs master policy provides coverage. The purchase of a Homeowners Form 6 or HO6 policy will provide this type of protection.

A late charge of \$25.00 or 5%, whichever is greater, <u>will</u> be charged for any payment received after the 15th of the month.

<u>AUTOMATIC HOA PAYMENTS:</u> For your convenience, Barrington Park can set up a reoccurring withdrawal (ACH) directly from your financial institution. It is easy, secure (no need to worry about fraud), and prevents late payments and late fees.
