HAPPY NEW YEAR FROM THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND MANAGEMENT: We have much to be grateful for, particularly all our neighbors and the people who make this such a wonderful community. It is our wish that you have a prosperous new year in your work and play, and with your family and friends. Again, Happy New Year!

### MAIL & PACKAGES: A few reminders regarding mail and package delivery:

- 1. UPS, FedEx, and Amazon will all deliver directly to your home. If you are expecting a package and will not be home, you may want to have it delivered to a neighbor or somewhere other than the front steps.
- 2. USPS (US Postal Service) will deliver to the parcel lockers by the mailboxes. Two new parcel lockers have been installed this past year; however, at times there are not enough parcel lockers.

## \*With the increase in online shopping and mail delivery, we strongly recommend that residents pick up their mail and packages <u>daily</u> rather than leaving them overnight.

**<u>SNOW & COLD WEATHER REMINDERS</u>**: A big thank you to the crew who worked to get everyone clear of snow and ice, this past month. We thank you your patience as they worked to keep up.

Here are a few other snow and cold weather reminders to keep you safe as we move into winter:

- Snow removal is completed when storms accumulate a depth of 2 or more inches.
- Streets: Streets are given a priority. The first areas are the entrances and around the post office, followed by the main streets and finally the side streets. Please remember, there is no parking on the streets overnight and no parking overnight in guest parking without a permit.
- Sidewalks and driveways: As with street plowing, sidewalks and driveways are completed on a priority system. First being the post office, next the major walk areas then the rest of the drives and walks. In other words, they will eventually get to you and are happy to do so. It simply takes time, so please be a little patient with us and know we will get to you. Any help that is provided by you is appreciated and expedites the whole snow removal process, allowing the crew to work on other things. The crew does not remove snow from patio or deck areas.
- Ice: Along with snow removal are the ice hazards that cold weather brings. Ice Melt (Not Salt) is available for owners (do not use salt on any of the cement surfaces). Please refrain from using ice melt or salt on the new cement. Ice melt is available by calling or picking up at the office.

<u>FREEZING PIPES</u>: No matter how new or old homes are, pipes that are in exterior walls can be susceptible to freezing when temperatures get cold. That is true of those pipes under sinks where no heat can get to the wall. When you believe the temperature is going to be cold for a period, open the cabinet doors and let some heat get to those walls. For areas such as showers or bathtubs, it wouldn't hurt to let a little water trickle just while it is cold. Along with freezing pipes be sure your outside hose is disconnected from the hose bib, and you want to be sure you can turn the water off to the hose either by a valve inside your home or that a freeze free valve is installed and working properly.

<u>CHRISTMAS DECORATIONS</u>: Homeowners should be pleased about the way Barrington Park looked during the Holidays. There were many great decorations, and it made the whole community look and feel festive. The Board wants to thank all those that did decorate. So that Barrington will look well kept, please remove your decorations before January 16, 2023, weather permitting. If you put your Christmas Trees at the curb, our maintenance crew will haul them off to the recyclers.

**<u>PARKING</u>**: As a reminder, anyone parking overnight in spots other than their assigned carports or driveways, must have a parking pass to do so. Temporary passes are free and may be obtained from the office. Long term passes, anything over two weeks, must be obtained from the office and there is a \$25.00 per month charge.

## <u>Please remember, a Barrington Park parking permit DOES NOT grant permission to park on the streets.</u> Vehicles CANNOT be parked on the street between the hours of midnight-6:00 AM.

It is easy, secure (no need to worry about fraud), and prevents late payments and late fees.
