<u>WHAT A STORM!</u> A BIG thank you to the crew who went to great lengths and worked incredibly long days to get Barrington Park cleared of snow and ice after the spectacular storm we had last month. Barrington Park received over 16 inches of snow which at times fell at over 1 inch an hour. A storm like that takes time to clear and we thank all who assisted in the snow removal and expressed appreciation for the crew and their hard work. It was greatly appreciated.

Here are a few other snow and cold weather reminders to keep you safe:

- Snow removal is completed when storms accumulate a depth of 2 or more inches.
- Streets: Streets are given a priority. The first areas are the entrances and around the post office, followed by the main streets and finally the side streets. Please remember, there is no parking on the streets overnight and no parking overnight in guest parking without a permit.
- Sidewalks and driveways: As with street plowing, sidewalks and driveways are completed on a priority system. First being the post office, next the major walk areas then the rest of the drives and walks.
- Ice: Along with snow removal are the ice hazards that cold weather brings. Ice Melt (not Salt) is available for owners (do not use salt on any of the cement surfaces).
- Ice melt is available by calling or picking up at the office.

**PET REMINDERS:** We are seeing an increase in pet related complaints and problems. As a reminder all pet waste must be cleaned up **IMMEDIATELY**. Please pick up your pet's waste so others don't step in it. Not picking up your pet's waste is an immediate minimum fine of \$100. Pets must **ALWAYS** be on a leash while outside. Pet leashes must be no longer than 16 feet. Not having your pet on a leash is an immediate minimum fine of \$100

<u>WE NEED YOUR EMAIL</u>: Barrington Park needs your email! When management needs to provide real-time updates regarding snow removal, trash pickup or even if the city needs to shut off the water temporarily. Unfortunately, we cannot call each homeowner. The fastest way to get this information out to homeowners is via email. To stay up to date, we encourage all homeowners to have an email address on file with Barrington Park.

## A FEW ANNOUNCEMENTS & REMINDERS:

- Tennis Courts- We hope the warmer weather is on its way and soon we will be installing the nets on the tennis courts. As a reminder a key is needed to access the tennis courts. If you don't have a key, please contact the office to make arrangement to get one.
- Gazebo Rental- The gazebo located south/west of the pool is available for residents to reserve. Please email the office at <u>office@barringtonparkhoa.com</u> for more information.
- Towing- We continue to see cars towed at Barrington Park on a frequent basis. Cars should not be parking on the street between midnight- 6:00 AM.
- Pool Opening- While it is hard to imagine but the pool will be opening before you know it! We wanted to remind you that pool privileges will be revoked if your account is not current.

## MAIL & PACKAGES- YOUR HELP IS NEEDED!! A few reminders regarding mail and package delivery:

- 1. UPS, FedEx, and Amazon will all deliver directly to your home. If you are expecting a package and will not be home, you may want to have it delivered to a neighbor or somewhere other than the front steps.
- 2. USPS (US Postal Service) will deliver to the parcel lockers by the mailboxes. Two new parcel lockers have been installed this past year; however, at times there are not enough space in parcel lockers due to packages not being picked up for many days.

HOW CAN YOU HELP? With the increase in online shopping and mail delivery, we strongly recommend that residents pick up their mail and packages <u>daily</u> rather than leaving them overnight. This will make space for daily delivery of packages. We thank you and the postal carrier thanks you as well!!

<u>AUTOMATIC HOA PAYMENTS</u>: For your convenience, Barrington Park can set up a reoccurring withdrawal (ACH) directly from your financial institution. It is easy, secure (no need to worry about fraud), and prevents late payments and late fees.
